

Working Student Scholarship Criteria

Effective Spring 2024 the following is the criteria for the Working Student scholarship:

- Must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours for the fall and/or spring. Must be enrolled in 3 credit hours for the summer.
- Must be enrolled in a curriculum program of study (Special Credit cannot receive scholarship)
- Must have a current FAFSA on file (unless student is a non-citizen)
- Must have a current scholarship application on file.
- Students who have withdrawn from a class(es) two or more semesters do not qualify.
- Must maintain a 2.0 program GPA.
- Students already awarded a scholarship(s) totaling \$500 may not be eligible for working student.

Students with an EFC greater than 25,000 will not be eligible for the Working Student Scholarship.
