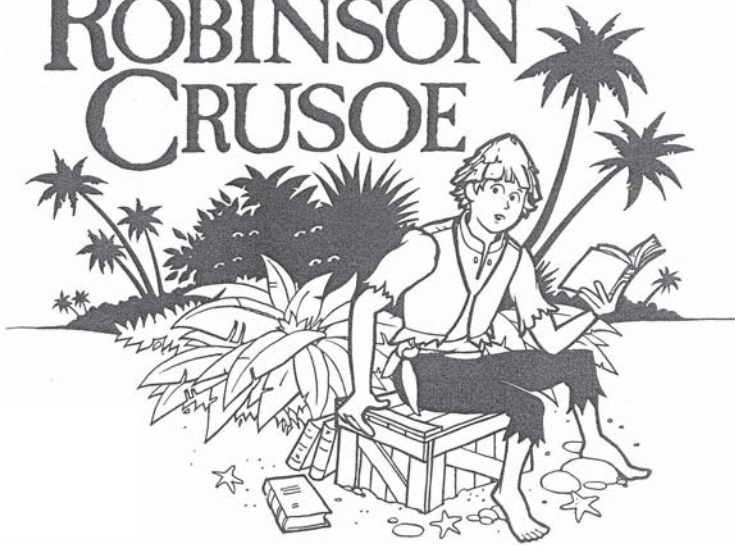

For over 30 years, Missoula Children's Theatre has provided quality education, entertainment, and enrichment for all ages through the performing arts. This season alone nearly 65,000 children will experience the role of a performer.

It is an opportunity for area children and teenagers who are **entering grades 1-12** to participate as performers in a production. Approximately 50 local students will be cast to appear in the show with the MCT Tour Actor/Director.

Auditions for the production will be held at the Cole Auditorium on Monday, August 3 at 9:45 a.m. Students wishing to audition must arrive by the scheduled starting time and stay for the entire two-hour session. The first rehearsal begins approximately 15-30 minutes after the audition. Bag lunches are encouraged. No advance preparation is necessary.



Rehearsals will begin at 10:00 a.m. and end at 2:30 p.m. on Monday, August 3, through Friday, August 7, with a 30-minute lunch break each day at 12:00 p.m. Although not all cast members will be needed at every session, those auditioning must have a clear schedule for the entire week and if selected, be able to attend all rehearsals required for their role. Lines, staging, songs, and dances are learned in this 4.5 hours of rehearsal each day.

Two performances of *The Amazing Adventures of Robinson Crusoe* will be presented on Saturday, August 8, at 4:00 p.m. & 7:00 p.m.
