Accounting	Master's degree with 18 graduate hours in accounting required.
Astronomy	Master's degree with 18 graduate hours in astronomy and/or physics required.
Biology	Master's degree with 18 graduate hours in biology required.
Nursing (clinical)	Bachelor's degree in nursing required, Master's degree preferred. Current unrestricted RN license required.
Computers	Master's degree with 18 graduate hours in computer courses preferred, Bachelor's degree in a computer related field required
Developmental English	Bachelor's degree in English required.
Developmental Mathematics	Bachelor's degree in mathematics required.
Developmental Reading	Master's degree with 18 graduate hours in reading required.
Drama	Master's degree with 18 graduate hours in drama required.
Early Childhood	Master's degree in early childhood education or Master's degree in education with 18 graduate hours in early childhood.
Engineering	Master's degree in mechanical engineering, computer engineering, electrical engineering or a related field required.
English	Master's degree with 18 graduate hours in English required.
History	Master's degree with 18 graduate hours in history required.
