



RCC Adds Drama Courses

Michael Fairley is bringing drama to Richmond Community College. Fairley, an English instructor at RCC, is teaching a new course on campus: Theater Appreciation.

“This class is basically a survey of theater. We’re examining periods of theater in America as well as the world,” Fairley explained. Seventeen students signed up for the new course.

“The students are having fun, but I think I’m having more fun than they are,” he shared.

Fairley recently received 18 graduate hours through the summer institutes of the University of Southern Maine, plus a certificate from the Institute of Readers Theatre in San Diego, Ca. He traveled to London and Toronto for the last two summers to attend workshops through the

program.

“The classes involve a lot of work and fun,” he added.
