

Interactive Science Show Coming in October

Scientific theory, a Russian scientist, comedy, and bananas mix together in an upcoming show at Richmond Community College's Cole Auditorium to create scientific demonstrations unlike anything you have ever seen. "Doktor Kaboom!" is a one-man science variety show that will be enjoyed by members of the entire family.

Doktor Kaboom, the host of the show, has been described as the happiest (and funniest) mad scientist who has ever lived. Doktor Kaboom is a fictional Russian scientist who was created and is played by actor and comedian David Epley.

The one-hour performance will be presented Monday, October 4th, at 7:00 p.m. at the Cole Auditorium as part of the 2010 Cole Community Series. The series and this show are open to the general public. One child 12 or under will be admitted free to the performance with each paying adult. Adult and additional children's tickets are \$10.00 each. All children, regardless of age, are required to have a ticket for admission.

The show is filled with fast-paced, educational experiments as Doktor Kaboom keeps the audience riveted with interest and rolling with laughter while exploring spectacular applications of the physical sciences. One demonstration breaks down the science behind using a catapult to toss a piece of a banana into the mouth of an audience member 15 feet away on the other side of the stage.

"This show is geared toward elementary and middle school students." Auditorium Director Joey Bennett said. "We wanted to do a program geared towards a little older audience than we have typically been reaching with our children programming. We are happy we are able to offer a free ticket to one child with each paying adult so more children can participate."
