Nursing Assistant I

This is a traditional classroom setting training program which is used to prepare an individual to successfully complete a NC State approved competency evaluation examination that allows the nurse aide to be listed on the NC Nurse Aide I Registry. Teaching is provided through instructor lectures, videos, roll playing methods and hands on learning. Upon successful completion of the course, the student will be able to take the state exam through Pearson VUE for listing and certification with the state of North Carolina.

A high school diploma or GED is not a requirement for admittance into the program.

Nursing Assistant I (Online/Hybrid)

This is a **136 contact hour course** offered with online instruction as well as hands on learning done in the classroom/lab and clinical settings. Coursework is done primarily online with the hands on learning portions done on alternating weekends. Upon successful completion of the course, the student will be able to take the state exam through Pearson VUE for listing and certification with the state of North Carolina. *A high school diploma or GED is not a requirement for admittance into the program.*

Phlebotomy Program (This class is full).

This course will prepare the student to obtain blood samples through three basic techniques: venipuncture, heel sticks, and finger sticks from patients of all ages. Furthermore, this course will familiarize the student with all aspects of a laboratory facility and prepare them to work in this field both in a hospital or clinical setting as a professional phlebotomist.

Pre-registration will be held on Tuesday, January 18th and Thursday, January 20th, from 8-5 p.m. at RCC/Main Campus, Lee Bldg. in the Workforce & Economic Development Unit.

Enrollment will be based on a first-come, first-serve basis. (*Limited to 20 students*)

Admission Requirements: HS Diploma/GED, Reading Test Score of at least a 67 or tested out of RED 090 w/B or better or have 2-year degree, present valid Social Security Card, valid Driver's License or ID, and pay the fee of \$189.25.

Books must be purchased before the first day of class at a cost of \$52.95.(price subject to change)

The student is responsible for presenting his/her test scores and/or transcripts during pre-registration. Documents required within two-weeks after class begins: Physical form from physician stating physical ability to complete training, TB Skin test (no older than 6-months from the start of class, Vaccination Record (MMR), Drug Screen (9-Panel), Hepatitis B Vaccine (must be started and two of the three shots taken prior to clinical), and a local criminal background check for the past 7 years covering each county/state lived in. **No exceptions!**
